Code of Conduct

Quamby Estate Golf's Code of Conduct calls for reasonable standards of behaviour from guests, visitors, and staff to ensure everyone experiences safe and equal enjoyment of the facilities on the estate. Although the code does not explicitly cover every possible situation, it is a strong general statement on the standards of behaviour(s) that are expected whilst at Quamby Estate.

Quamby Estate Management reserve the right to ask you to leave the estate should this code of conduct not be adhered to. For members, Quamby Estate reserves the right to terminate your membership in the event of behaviour misconduct.

The principles of good sportsmanship and common courtesy is essential for an enjoyable for all concerned at the Estate.

1. DRESS CODE:

- Wear proper golf attire, including a collared shirt and enclosed shoes.
- Avoid inappropriate clothing and non-traditional golf attire.
- Thongs or open sandals on the course are not permitted during play.

2. PACE OF PLAY:

- Play at a reasonable pace and be aware of your group's position on the course.
- Please give way to competition players on the course.
- Allow faster groups to play though if you are slower.

3. RESPECT TO OTHERS:

- Keep noise to a minimum on the course, including mobile phones.
- Do not disturb other players by talking loudly, engaging in disruptive behaviour, or using obscene language.
- Be respectful of other staff members, visitors, and guests and neighbours of the Estate.
- Unwelcome advances or physical contact directed at staff or guests will not be tolerated.
- Quamby Estate has a zero tolerance towards discrimination of any kind, harassment and/or bullying towards staff or guests.
- Repair divots and ball marks on the greens.

4. GOLF ETIQUETTE:

- Allow the player who is farthest from the hole to play first (unless agreed otherwise).
- Do not walk through another player's putting on the green.
